3 Deblisterer Setup and Operation


- Ensure there are the correct number of tabs on the punch plate for the type of cards you are using.
 - o EX: To punch out a 30 count card you only want 30 tabs (not 31).
- Place punch plate into receptacle plate
- Insert plates into deblisterer
- Use thumb screws to mount the plates to the deblisterer
- Slide catch tray into deblisterer
- Open deblisterer and insert prepack card (face up, bottom first)
- Close deblisterer
- Remove catch tray

6 Maintenance

The plates and the catch tray can all be cleaned with warm water and soap after each medication.

Beyond keeping the Deblisterer clean, no other maintenance should be required.
